

Brown's Creek Watershed District Rules Schedule A—Permit Fee Deposit

On December 10, 2007, the Brown's Creek Watershed District (BCWD) Board of Managers adopted Resolution 07-11 establishing a revised permit fee deposit schedule. This permit fee deposit schedule will apply to all permit applications received as complete on or after January 1, 2008. The permit fee deposit for submittal of a Brown's Creek Watershed District permit is pursuant to 103D.345 and BCWD Rule 8.0 and is as follows:

Water Resource Permit Fee Deposit

The amount of the permit fee deposit is reviewed and revised by the BCWD Board on an annual basis or otherwise as warranted. An application is not deemed complete until the required fee deposit has been submitted. Each permit fee deposit is kept in an escrow account and applied to reimburse the BCWD for costs incurred. When a project is approved by the BCWD Board, the permit fee deposit must be replenished to the deposit amount by the applicant before the permit will be issued, to cover actual costs incurred to monitor compliance after permit issuance and address non-compliance with the permit or BCWD Rules. **Any costs incurred by the BCWD greater than the permit fee deposit balance will be billed to the applicant.** Any unused portion of the deposit balance will be returned to the applicant when the Board determines that the work has been completed under the permit. The permit fee deposit is as stated below.

Greater than 4 lots	\$100/additional lot
Rule 2.2b-f – All other stormwater rule applications	\$3,000
b) Rule 3.0 Erosion Control	
Activities/Grading less than 1 acre	\$1,000
1.0 - 4.99 acres	\$1,250
5.0 - 19.9 acres	\$1,500
20 or more acres	\$2,000
c) Rule 5.0 Shoreland and Streambank Alterations	\$1,500
d) Rule 6.0 Stream and Lake Crossings	\$1,500
e) Rule 7.0 Floodplain and Drainage Alterations	\$500

FOR WORK REQUIRING REVIEW UNDER MORE THAN ONE OF THE ABOVE RULES, THE PERMIT FEE DEPOSIT WILL BE CUMULATIVE.

Brown's Creek Watershed District Rules Schedule B—District Costs

On May 12, 2003, the Brown's Creek Watershed District (BCWD) Board adopted Resolution 03-03 establishing a permit fee deposit schedule. The permit fee deposit for submittal of a Brown's Creek Watershed District permit is pursuant to 103D.345 and the BCWD Rules 8.0 and 9.0, which allow the District to apply a permit fee to cover actual costs related to permitting, including site inspections, analysis of the proposed activity, services of consultants, and compliance assurance.

The actual costs to the District to be reimbursed out of the fee deposit and/or charged to the permittee directly will be calculated based on the rates at which permit-related services are provided to the District. Brown's Creek Watershed District Rules Schedule C—Permit Performance Sureties

Performance Surety Deposit

Pursuant to Resolution 03-03, the BCWD Board establishes performance surety amounts, in addition to the permit fee deposit. The performance surety will be used to ensure the completion of work in accordance with the permit. The performance surety for issuance of a Brown's Creek Watershed District permit is pursuant to 103D.345 and the BCWD Rule 9.0 and shall be as follows:

Area of Activity Performance Surety Amount

Grading or Alteration \$2000/acre

** No surety is required for a project undertaken by or for a resident owner on a single-family home site requiring only an erosion control permit under Rule 3.0, unless the board determines that the project presents a significant risk of damage to water resources from erosion.*

Stormwater Mgt Facilities *125% of estimated construction cost

*No Stormwater Mgt Facilities surety is necessary if applicant can demonstrate that the municipality has received equal or greater performance surety amount from applicant.

MINIMUM PERFORMANCE SURETY (WHEN REQUIRED) OF \$5,000
